

## **Kansas State Council ENA**

### **Nursing Scholarship**

The Kansas State Council of the Emergency Nurses Association, wishing to support emergency nursing as a profession has set up funding for two scholarships in the amount of \$500 to be awarded each semester beginning with the spring semester 2010 and continuing. This scholarship is available for any person pursuing an Associates or Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing or an Advanced Practice Degree in Nursing with a focus on Emergency Nursing.

#### Qualifications:

1. The applicant must be accepted into an NLN accredited nursing program.
2. The applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
3. The applicant must live in Kansas or be currently employed in healthcare in Kansas.
4. The completed application must be received by the committee 30 days prior to the beginning of the semester for which the application is being made.

#### Procedure for application:

Submit the completed application with:

1. Two letters of reference, one personal and one professional
2. Provide a summary of work experience and extracurricular activities (volunteer opportunities, awards, etc.)
3. Submit a one page letter giving a summary of the reasons for pursuing a career in nursing. This should include how the applicant intends to apply this education to the practice of emergency nursing.
4. Provide a copy of all transcripts.
5. Provide a copy of the letter of acceptance into an NLN accredited program.

The scholarship committee will review all applications and select the recipients.
